Institution started Centre for Disabled (Treatment & Rehabilitation) at Ayodhya General Hospital. The project is sponsored by Department of Disability Affairs, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India, New Delhi. We provide services to all type of Disabled population like Hearing Impairment, Vision Impairment, Physically Handicapped, Locomotors Impairment & Mentally retarded. We conduct Free Disabilities Detection Camps for detection of the disabilities and provide them Aids/appliances as per their needs. After fitting of aids/appliances we give them proper training to the patients and their parents 'How to Use' the aids / appliances and plan for their rehabilitation. During the year 2013-2014 we have given benefits for 2109 Disabled patients through our Centre.

D) COMMUNITY BASED REHABILITATION through RURAL HEALTH PROGRAMME - in Purandar Tehsil, Dist. Pune

Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India, extend & sanction special project to our institute for three years - 2012-13 to 2014-15 under 35 AC of Income Tax name as "**Community Based Rehabilitation through Rural Health Programme**".

The project has been divided in three parts which is as follows:

1. Rural Health Services
2. Services to Disabled personse specially for Hearing Impairment
3. In Door facilities for Rural & Urban population at Ayodhya General Hospital, Wanwadi, Pune.

1. Rural Health Services:

Institution adopted 20 villages from Purander Tehsil. We provide O.P.D. services in all villages. The team of Medical & Para-medical staff provides services in above villages. While giving the O.P.D. services if they found any emergency they will shift to the patients at our Hospital, Wanwadi and give further treatment.

We also conduct the free Disability detection camp at Purandar Tehsil and cover all block - 116 villages and 2 cities. During the year we have provided our services to -

2. Services to Disabled especially to Hearing Impairment:

Institution started Residential School for Deaf & Research Centre and Centre for Disabled at Wanwadi. We have adopted 80 Hearing Impaired children where all facilities including Education, Lodging & Boarding provide free of cost. We provide services to H.I. children like

- Free Special Education
- Free Lodging & Boarding facilities
- Personality development activities

3. In-door services at Ayodhya General Hospital:

Institution provides Indoor facilities to poor population to those can't afford the expenses of hospital. We provide these services in very concessional charges to Zilla Parishad & Municipal Corporation Schools. We have also provided our services to children with special needs under Serva Shiksha Abhiyan. During the year we have done surgical corrections of **784 children Free of Cost.**

E) SARVASHIKSHAABHIYAN PROGRAMME:

Government of India started Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan Project in 2000-01. The Universalization of the Elementary Education is the basic aims of this project. Education for children with Special needs is one of the important. Objective in S.S.A. children with special needs will be supported by Government in all the way.

Our Institute is supporting to Government of Maharashtra by contributing different activities these are.

1) SRG / DRG Membership:

The Director of trust is member of SRG M.P.S.P., Govt. of M.H., Mumbai & DRG (District Resource Group) Pune

2) Foundation Course on Education of Children with Disability:

Rehabilitation Council of India – New Delhi and Indira Gandhi National Open University – New Delhi conducts Foundation Course of 90 days. We have not trained Normal teachers from various districts during the academic year 2013-14.

3) SUPPORTIVE SERVICES TO SCERT:

Staff of our institute supported to SCERT Pune to implement various programmes and to develop the material on various subjects. We have also supported to preparation of Handbooks for Political Representative, Handbook for trainers and hand books for General educators.

4) EXPERT SERVICES FOR ASSESSMENT OF HEARING LOSS AND PROVIDE NEED BASE SERVICES:-

The Expert Medical & Para-medical & Professional team of our institute helps to MPSP and various Education Department Zilla Parishad & Municipal Corporations to detection of hearing loss of Hearing Impaired children.

F) REHABILITATION COUNCIL OF INDIA PROGRAMME:

COLLEGE OF SPECIAL EDUCATION:

STATE NODAL AGENCY (Under the National Project by R.C.I. & MHRD to implement the Foundation Course on Education of children with Disabilities (FCECD) Programme through online mode at Diat / BRC or other Centres under SSA / RMSA for the State).

THE NEED FOR SPECIAL EDUCATORS/PROFESSIONALS IN THE FIELD OF DISABILITY REHABILITATION AND SPECIAL EDUCATION.

The Government of India's flagship programme Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), which is the core of Right to Education Act, lays special emphasis on providing education to 'children with special needs'. SSA has been harmonized with the RTE Act. A landmark judgment by the Hon'ble Delhi High Court has resulted in increased demand for trained special teachers to be appointed two in each school of NCT of Delhi. Similar demand is expected to be created in other States and UTs with National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) granting approval to B.Ed. (SE) and D.Ed. (SE) qualifications for appointment of elementary teachers in general schools. Chances of securing a job in Govt. departments, medical and paramedical services, NGOs, in public as well as private sectors are bright.

A) REGULAR MODE COURSES:

1) Diploma in Education – Special Education – Deaf & Hard of Hearing D.Ed. SE (DHH):

Diploma in Special Education is the first ManPower Development programme started in 1999 at Ayodhya Charitable Trust Pune as well Rehabilitation Council of India has given special recognition and approval to our institute to conduct the D.Ed. SE (DHH) 2 years full time course with 4 semester pattern, recognized by R.C.I. and examination conducted by Ali Yavar Jung National Institute of Hearing Handicapped, Mumbai.

1. Intake capacity - 25 candidates per year.

2. Admission procedure: All India Aptitude Test for admission conducting by Rehabilitation Council of India (R.C.I) through online and paper pencil test.. Admission procedure starts from April.

3. Eligibility criteria: 10 + 2 or its equivalent examination.

4. Application procedure: Application can either be made online or submitted on prescribed application form given by R.C.I.

5. ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES:

The academic activities are being completed during June 2013 to May 2014, including theory and practical course. Special features of the course are:

I) Theory Course: The Lecture-cum demonstration method is used to complete the theory course successfully, with effective use of audio-visual aids i.e. OHP, LCD projector, T.V., C.D. player etc. We have also arranges various subject experts as Guest Lectures.

II) Practical course:

A) Special school visits: In practical course, students are provided complete exposure to the problem areas and rehabilitation options for the children with

special needs. Local and out station special school visits are arranged for the D.Ed. students.

- B) **Health and awareness activities:** Institute had arranged various health and awareness activities such as World Disabled Day, National Pulse Polio Immunization etc. Students were actively participated in the activities.
- C) **CBR Project:** A community survey for disability detection was conducted by the students and project was completed under the guidance of Director, Mr. L.E. Kagne. Areas covered were: Hadapsar & Wanwadi area, Pune.
- D) **Hearing aid care and maintenance and Ear mould workshop** Experts were invited to give demonstrations to the trainees. Students have completed the Audiology and speech practical satisfactorily.
- E) **Psychology Practical:** Various Psychological tests such as DAM, SPM, DST, VSMS, were observed and conducted by the trainees. Case studies of DHH children's were also completed by trainees. Practical on Guidance and counseling was completed.
- F) **Study tour: D.Ed. (HI) Students** were given exposure to observe some of the model schools at Mumbai such as:
1. Ali Yavar Jung National Institute For Hearing Handicapped Mumbai.
 2. (ADAPT), Bandra, Mumbai
 3. CITD., Mumbai

III) **Extra Curricular activities:** We have conducted Sports activities in January 2014. All the students have participated in programmes and enjoyed a lot.

IV) **Assessment and Evaluation System:** Ongoing internal assessment was carried out throughout the year conducting class testes, assignments, Pre mid, mid term and post mid term and preliminary examinations. Students were given guidelines for the final theory and practical examination.

V) **SUCCESS:**

D.Ed (SE) ((DHH))- First year: All students appeared for 1st & 2nd semester D.Ed. SE (DHH) Ali Yavar Jung National Institute of Hearing Handicapped examination held in Dec. 2013 and May / June 2014.

DSE (HI)- Second year: All the students appeared in 2nd year (1st, 2nd & 3rd semester) exam. They appeared 4th semester IGNOU University Examination held in June 2013. The result of last semester declared in March 2014. 83% students successfully passed with distinction and 1st class..

II) **Diploma in Hearing Language & Speech (D.H.L.S.):**

Rehabilitation Council of India recognized the Diploma in Hearing, Language & Speech to our institute in academic year 2002-2003. It is recognized by R.C.I. New Delhi & A.Y.J.N.I.H.H., Mumbai. This is one year practical oriented programme, for seeking admission in DHLS required 12th Science P.C.B., P.C.M. admission procedure starts every year in the month of May / June. .

Rehabilitation Council of India change the curriculum in year 2009-10. There are 6 theory papers and 4 practical papers; they have 60% of practical work. The assessment of students is done during the tenure in terms of pre-mid term exam, mid-term exam, class test, post mid term and the end there will be final theory examination conducted by A.Y.J.N.I.H.H. Mumbai. They have to attend final Speech and Audiology Oral Viva. The successful candidates who pass in theory and practical examination will be awarded the degree by Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) and they can work as a Speech and Hearing technician or Assistant Speech Therapist in different set-up like Govt. Set up, semi-govt. set up, private set up, they are in too much of demand in society.

As there were no students for DHLS course it is been declared as ZERO year,

III. Bachelor of Education – Special Education – Hearing Impairment B.Ed. SE(H.I.):

The B.Ed. (Special education) Programme aims to develop teachers for children with Hearing Impairment for various settings. The B.Ed. (Special Education) Hearing Impairment course will prepare human resources to enable them to acquire knowledge and develop competencies and skills to impart education and training effectively to all children including children with Hearing Impairment.

The B.Ed. (Special Education) Programme aims to prepare the students for the following:

- i) To acquire knowledge about change in the prevailing and emerging Indian society in view of recent trends in education and national development.
- ii) To identify the special needs of children to develop confidence in them to realize their potentials and abilities to meet the national development with self respect, dignity and freedom.
- iii) To develop skills and competencies to cater to the needs of children with disabilities in general, and special class settings in particular, in cognitive affective and skill domains.
- iv) To equip in various techniques of teaching and evaluation in special and inclusive setup.

The Rehabilitation Council of India, New Delhi has recognized this course and University of Pune has affiliated our institute to run this course.

General frame work of the course:

The B.Ed. Special Education (Hearing Impairment) course consist of theory papers as per the following scheme.

i) Common papers	:	4

Duration of the course:

The duration of the course is one academic year.

Academic activities of the B.Ed. (Hearing Impairment) course during 2013-14.:

2010-11 academic year was the 1st batch of B.Ed. (Hearing Impairment) Regular mode.

20 students have enrolled in the programme . Male 13 Female 7

2011-12 academic year was the 2nd batch of B.Ed. (Hearing Impairment) regular mode.

24 students have enrolled in the programme Male 17 Female 7

2012-13 academic year was the 3rd batch of B.Ed. (H.I) regular mode 20 students have enrolled in the programme Male 09 and Female 11.

2013-14 academic year was the 4th batch of B.Ed. (H.I) regular mode 17 students have enrolled in the programme Male 07 and Female 10.

Admission procedure:

The admission to B.Ed. (Hearing Impairment) regular full time course for the year 2013-14 has completed through Maharashtra Vinanudan Adhyapak Mahavidyalay Sanstha chalak Association as well as University wise conducting common entrance test taking into consideration the merit and the performance given by the students in the Oral interview.

Eligibility:

Candidates of having recognized university degree with minimum 50% marks for OBC / Open category and 45% marks for reserve category.

Conduction of Theory & Practical work of B.Ed (H.I):

The programme has 9 theory papers and practical such as teaching practice, Audiology, Speech, Sign language, Language and Communication and inclusive school teaching practice etc.

- 1) **Method of conducting theory:** The Lecture cum demonstration method and project method has been used for delivering lecture. During lectures students have received the exposure of Educational technology material like LCD, Projector, OHP, DVD player, Television, RCI Tele-conferencing etc .
- 2) **Practical:** In practical students got exposure of –
 - i) Practice teaching / classroom placement.
 - ii) Micro teaching and simulated teaching
 - iii) Individualized teaching lesson
 - iv) Language and communication skills of the teacher trainees
 - v) Disability Orientation for the teachers

 - vii) Community Based Rehabilitation
 - viii) Adaptation of teaching strategies and evaluation
 - ix) Parent Empowerment
 - x) Visit to Rehabilitation Institutes

 - xii) Assessing and teaching Speech Psychology
 - xiii) Skill development in sign language or signed system.

The students have received the exposure of different Special schools of Hearing Impaired teaching Methodology and they have also visited the Ali Yavar Jung National Institute for the Hearing Handicapped Mumbai.

Assessment and Evaluation System:

Continuous Internal Assessment was carried out during their academic session. The trainees have to undergo through Pre-mid term, Mid term and Preliminary examinations as well as classroom presentation. The final theory examination will be held from 19th May 2014 to 28th May 2014. The result of B.Ed. (HI) students will be declared in June 2014.

Distance Education in Hearing Impairment
B.Ed. SE DE(H.I)

Rehabilitation Council of India with collaboration Indira Gandhi National Open University New Delhi has recognized and affiliated our institute to run Distance Education programme in Special Education & Rehabilitation.

According to National Convention for the Educator's of the Deaf 2005, We are in need of 9.4 lac Special Educators in our country. Regular programme only cannot cater the needs of the country in the area of Special Education. To catering the needs, Rehabilitation Council of India in collaboration with Indira Gandhi National Open University has started the Distance Education programme in the field of Special Education. Ours is a recognized Study Centre for the same.

For the academic year 2012-13 we have admission of 27 students in IInd year & 33 in Ist year B.Ed. SE-DE (H.I).

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE:

This programme has been designed judiciously with aim of theory and practical courses to develop knowledge, skills and attitude in the special educators. The self instructional material has been designed by IGNOU to expose the educators to various aspects in teaching the children with disabilities. The programme consists of the following five groups of course.

**II) The Post Graduate Professional Diploma
in Special Education Hearing Impairment
P.G.P.D. – SE-DE (HI)**

The Post graduate Professional Diploma (PGPD) in Special education Programme is being offered by the National Centre for Disability Studies (NCDS), IGNOU in collaboration with Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI). The programme is of 32 credits.

The inclusion in general education schools of all levels has led to more children with disabilities in General School Classrooms, the need for teachers to keep up to speed on how to best teach their increasingly-diverse students has grown. With distance learning, these general education teachers got a convenient and valuable opportunity to earn a special education Diploma.

Objectives of the Programme:

The main objective of the programme is to impart the required knowledge, understanding, attitude and skill to a 'General Classroom Teacher' to provide education inputs to Children with Disabilities, apart from developing faith, sense of freedom, self-respect and dignity within them. This makes them to develop a sense of independence to contribute their services to the society and the nation.

Eligibility for admission:

B.Ed. in General Education

Medium of Instruction:

The medium of instruction is English. The Self Instructional Materials will be available in English. Steps are taken to make Hindi version available. The Curricular transaction may be in English/Hindi and the Assignments, Practical Records, Internal Assessment Tests may be written by the candidate in English / Hindi. The Term End Examination will be held in English / Hindi.

Duration:

Minimum duration – 1 year and maximum 3 years.

Programme Structure:

The Programme of Post Graduate Professional Diploma in Special education Distance Education Programme (PGPD-SEDE Programme) will consist of 8 courses, 4 Theory courses and 4 Practical courses.

PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION

Curricular Transaction: The distance education mode of implementation of this programme will follow the multi-media approach in imparting instruction to the learners comprising:

- Self-instructional material;
- Assignments for assessment and feedback;
- Contact programmes
- Teaching practice in special schools;
- Project work in the field

III) Post Graduate Diploma in Disability Management – PGDMD (For Doctors)

This is a one year distance course in special education launched by IGNOU & R.C.I. in Jan. 2010. This course is specially designed only for the Medical practitioners (MBBS, BHMS, BAMS, etc.) who wish to work as Rehabilitation professional. The admission procedure is twice in a year i.e. in January & June Term end examinations are also conducted twice.

Till date 4 students have completed their PGDMD.

IV) Foundation Course on "Education for Children with Disabilities" (F.C. SE-DE):

Rehabilitation Council of India, New Delhi, and Indira Gandhi National (Open) University, New Delhi jointly offers this course through Distance Mode.

Its aims to develop understanding and basic competencies in teacher for dealing children with various disabilities.

The course will be of 3 months (90 days) duration including 3 weeks of Face-to-face contact programme in two phases. It includes Theory & Practical work to be completed by each trainee.

During the academic year 2013-14 we have not conducted any batches of Foundation course as follows:

V) Foundation Course on Education of "Children with Disabilities" (F.C. E.C.D.) online mode:

Rehabilitation Council of India, New Delhi, offers Online Mode.

- State Nodal Agency – R.C.I. selected us the State Nodal Agency for State of Maharashtra to implement online Foundation Course through BRC & other centres.

- Its aims to develop the required competencies of the in-service general teacher and enable them to teach in inclusive classroom

- To inform general teacher on the entitlements for CWSN under the RTE Act/.

The course will be of 10 sessions in a calendar year and each session will be of 3 months (90 days) duration each session includes 12 days of Skill Training Programme (STP) of 84 hours of Face-to-face contact programme. It includes Theory & Practical work to be completed by each trainee.

During the academic year 2013-14 we have not conducted batch of Foundation course.

VI) Continuing Rehabilitation Education Programme (C.R.E. Programme):

Rehabilitation Council of India started the CRE Programme for Special Educators, Audiologists & Social Workers to upgrade their knowledge in Special Education since 2001-02. During the year 2013-2014 we have organized 4 CRE programmes. These are:

G) RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL FOR DEAF AND RESEARCH CENTRE – 2013-14

Ayodhya Charitable trust started Residential School for Deaf and Research Centre during academic year 2000-2001.

The project has been started for the Educational Rehabilitation of Hearing Impaired children.

The school has started in July 2000 with 5 Hearing Impaired students, today we have 85 H.I. children took benefit of school.

The Government of Maharashtra has given Grant-in-Aid in 2004 for 40 children and remaining were in Non-grantable i.e.

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ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES:

The Special School was started with 5 students in beginning and today we have 85 Deaf students from different places from Maharashtra.

We provide them Free Education, Food, Shelter and Clothes and provide them individual Hearing Aids along with Ear Mould & Chargeable Solar Batteries. Two classes covered by B.T.E. Hearing Aid.

Assessment of Hearing Loss:

All students assess by our Chief E.N.T. surgeon and Audiologist and Speech Therapist. After having their recommendation, we admit the students in school. All students were also assessed by Medical Superintendent - Sassoon General Hospital - Pune and Civil Surgeon Aundh Hospital Pune and they issued the Disability Certificate.

Aids & Appliances:

After the assessment of Hearing loss and recommendation by Audiologist we provide them individual Hearing Aids to all the students according to their Hearing loss. We provide them Binaural Hearing Aids to all students except 2 to 3 students. All Hearing Aids is received from Serva Shiksha Abhiyan

Equipments:

A) BERA, Impedance Audiometers :

B) Group Hearing Aids: We have purchased 4 Group Hearing Aids system of 8 students for improvement of the Hearing capacity of student. We have 4 Group Hearing Aids at our school during 2013-14.

C) Loop Induction System: We have made arrangement of Loop Induction System in one class. This is new thing institution started as a Research part and for Pre-Primary I class.

D) Computerized Speech Therapy Programme: British High Council has donated Computerized Speech Therapy Programme i.e. "Dr. Speech". With the help of Dr. Speech our Speech Therapist develops the speech & language. We have developed various Software in Marathi language for improvement of language of each deaf child. Each Deaf student undergoes the training of Dr. Speech simultaneously. With the results we had develop the Speech of language of children

E) Speech Trainer: Institution has 7 Speech Trainer with mirror to improve the language of deaf student. The Special Teacher teaches each student with the help of Speech Trainer in front of mirror. We have given 5 speech trainers in all pre-primary class rooms.

F) Sound Proof Room: Institution prepared/designed ideal two room set-up Sound Proof Room. We have applied the latest technology while preparing the room. This is a unique room prepared for the correct assessment of Hearing Loss. We have inserted/fitted talk back system in Sound Proof Room.

G) Audiometers: Institution has 5 Audiometer for Assessment of hearing loss. We perform 14 types of various tests on the Audiometers and another has a Portable Audiometer, Screening audiometer, infantile audiometer etc.

H) Speech Therapy Rooms: Institution has 6 Speech Therapy rooms. In this room individual speech training is given to develop their speech.

Sound Level Meters: Institution has three Sound Level Meters for Assessment of Noise level in various places. We have Portable (Hand) Sound level Meter, Octave

E) Band Analyzers Sound Level Meter and 2231 Computerized Sound Level Meter which will continuously collected data on 31 hours.

F) Ear Mould Lab: Institution started Ear Mould Lab with all equipments and all accessories. All type of ear mould prepared in our School for better communication between two persons. We prepared Pocket Model, BTE & ITC Ear Mould.

G) Hearing Aid repairing room: Institution has four sets of Hearing Aids repair and servicing with qualified technician. Institution has 20-bedded well- equipped hospitals in premises of institution. E.N.T Depart. is one of major department in hospital which give the services to the Hearing Impaired population.

H) B.T.E. Hearing Aid : All students are given B.T.E. Hearing Aid of Star Key or Electrode company.

I) Teaching Learning Material: We have developed & purchased the teaching learning material for the school, which develops the language of deaf child. T.L.M. is very important task in Educational Programme of the Hearing Impaired School.

- J) **E-learning programme:** All students are taught by e-learning programme methods which is easier for children of Hearing Impaired children.
- K) **Sport Equipment:** We have purchased the sport equipments for the development of physical aspects of the deaf children.
- L) **Computer room :** Computer 5 with printer is available for students at our school.
